Move your website to us, quickly and without any hassles! Here's how...

Step 1 - Move your website files to Push Button Hosting.

Open your new PushButtonHosting.co.uk account. This will give you instant access to your new web space, allowing you to start transferring your website files instantly. Make sure you select the option for 'transferring in an existing domain name' when entering your hosting details.

Instructions:

- If you have already registered a domain name you want to use with your new *Push Button Hosting Account* [click here](#), to continue to the next step
- However if you wish to Register a **NEW DOMAIN** name just enter the domain you want and click **Search**.

Step 2 - Tell us your existing website domain name.

Simply enter the domain name for the website you are moving to Push Button Hosting on the next page so we set up your account ready for when you point your domain name towards our servers.

Step 3 - Finalise your account details and make checkout.

To make sure your website doesn't suffer any downtime, it is recommended use the same name(s) for your file directories and create e-mail accounts using the same username's that you had with your old host. If you were running any scripts on your previous host, make sure the new installation has the correct working paths on our servers. And set all file permissions. If you have any difficulties please contact us.

Step 4 - Point your domain name to Push Button Hosting.

When you have uploaded all your pages, text, images etc. to your new webhosting account. Just point your domain name to the Push Button Hosting Name Servers (DNS servers). This is done by using the control panel for your domain name. (with the company that you registered the domain name with).

Push Button Hosting's DNS information:

NS.MAINNAMESERVER.COM
NS2.MAINNAMESERVER.COM

Once you have pointed it, your domain name may usually take 24-48 hours to propagate and become available worldwide. If you need help with the process of pointing your domain name, check out our video tutorials... we've covered the process in full using all the major domain registrars.

Most domain registrars give you a username and a password to modify the DNS settings, you'll need this information to point your domain name to us.

If you don't have this information or if you registered your domain name with a company other than the ones mentioned above, we suggest you give your current web hosting company or your registrar a call and ask for this information... telephone is always faster and more effective for this purpose.

Step 5 - Close your old hosting account.

Once your website is fully functional and running entirely on Push Button Hosting, close down your account with your old web host and you're done!
